**Matters Arising:**

Ray Russell has not replied to us about World Car Free day (22<sup>nd</sup> September) so it seems like a non-starter.

Peak bikes is reported as moving to Chatsworth Rd, near Nonnas-some time soon.

**Membership report:**

305 members. In April we lost 21% and May 25% of our membership due to non renewal. Previous to this nearly everyone else has renewed. It was speculated that this could be due to the recession or children getting to 18 and family now renewing.

**Treasurer's report:**

We have £2778.49 in the bank with a cheque for £149.79 due to come out for newsletters and leaflets. Leaving a balance of £2628.70.

**Secretary's report:**

East Midlands Cycle Forum is on 2<sup>nd</sup> October in Nottingham. If anyone wants to go you can enrol online ( HYPERLINK "http://www.pedals.org.uk" [www.pedals.org.uk](http://www.pedals.org.uk)) for £5.00-which includes refreshments and a buffet.

Simon Tranter met AM on Newbold Road/Littlemoor roundabout, outside the Nags head to discuss the change to traffic lights. An Advanced Stop Line and two pedestrian crossings. There may be some filters installed. The road leaving town will have two lanes and they may widen the road on Littlemoor for people turning left into town.

Work has started on building Hollingwood visitors' centre.

There will be a transport users group meeting on Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> September.

The Community Sport Network meeting on 27<sup>th</sup> September. AM has been co-opted into the cycle campaign.

DCC are having a Cycle meeting on 29<sup>th</sup> September.

Peter Cook, sustainability officer for CBC, has asked if the campaign will go to an event for businesses, focussing on green issues. It is on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> October at the Football

Club, 10-2pm. Organised by the chamber of commerce. AM will go with a stall.  
Two campaign members have spoken to AM about the railway station-several bikes (about 12) seem to have been there a long time and not moved. AM to go and investigate as they are taking up space.

DCC grants are available for sustainable transport matters. £1000 for revenue projects and £5000 for capital funding. We need to apply by 30<sup>th</sup> September and spend any money we get by 31<sup>st</sup> March 2011. We will put in a bid for £1000, and match fund it with £500 doing a new print of our new maps. We are not sure how the map is getting along.  
Possible use capital money for bike racks-would probably have to be on private land rather than council land as cost of putting it on council land is an unknown cost.

The PCT is offering another grant for £250-5,000 called "healthy Place Award" for environmental and health related projects. Needs to be in by 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2010. We could apply for more map printing money.

Later this week is a Chesterfield and N.E. Derbyshire countryside access meeting. It is a transfer of information between groups who use the countryside. It concentrates more on the outskirts of Chesterfield. Arkwright trails have not got a good surface, and will be mentioned.
